If neither of the parties to this agreement so notifies the other; it is mutually agreed that this shall constitute conclusive evidence that the parties have renewed this agreement for another year.

If approved, payment of current annual membership dues of \$10.00 is required. In subsequent years, payment of annual membership dues, in an amount as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine, shall be required.

To maintain voting privileges a member must "Maintain an Annual Business Relationship with the Association." This means a member who does at least 40% of his gross dollar business through the Association with a minimum annual patronage with the Association in gross dollars of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or as amended annually by the Board of Directors.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. INSTRUCTIONS

This certificate must be presented to a seller when making an exempt purchase. The farmer's exemption does not apply to purchases which will not be used directly and primarily in farm production. The purchases of automobiles, certain other motor vehicles, natural gas, electricity and any materials used to build a building or structure (except silos, greenhouses, grain bins and manure handling facilities) are taxable regardless of the intended use on a farm or by a farmer.
